

Town of Bartlett Office of Selectmen

Meeting Minutes: January 14, 2010

Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Doug Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

The Selectmen worked on the town budget for 2011.

Police Chief Timothy Connifey met with the Selectmen to discuss the following:

- 1.) He is having problems with snowmobilers going on private property and will be issuing a criminal trespass notice today.
- 2.) There is an EMT CPR training class being held by SOLO. It is a 180 hour class and Officer Cheryl Harris and Officer Ed Conley would like to take the class. The tuition is \$400.00 per person and the Bartlett Jackson Ambulance Service is going to look into paying for half the tuition. The officers will have to work some for the ambulance service. The Officers will be cross trained and be able to assist the ambulance service when needed. Connifey assured the Selectmen that their duties will be to be Officers first and EMT personnel second. Selectman Tanguay inquired if the new Officers True and Sutton were trained in CPR. Connifey believes that Sutton just was at the police academy and that True will be while he is at the academy. The Selectmen were in favor of the training and agreed to pay \$200.00 per officer to take the class.
- 3.) Jackson Police Department is hosting a class for certification to work on guns. The class is put on by Glock and the cost is \$150.00. Officer Conley who is the firearms instructor for Bartlett would like to attend. Selectman Tanguay inquired what happens if something goes wrong, who is liable. Connifey stated that he will be certified by Glock to work on the guns. The guns are inspected twice a year after qualifications. Connifey stated that it should save the town money to have Conley certified to work on them as the only additional cost would be if parts are needed. The Selectmen are ok with this and will pay the \$150.00 tuition fee.
- 4.) Chief Connifey has been working further with two potential part-time officers who are interested in working for Bartlett Police Department. It was agreed that one will come in next Friday the 21st to meet with the Selectmen.
