Meeting Minutes: January 15, 2010

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

The Selectmen met from 08:35 AM until 10:00 AM with the Solid Waste District Committee. (See separate minutes).

Bob King, Emergency Management Director, met with the Selectmen in reference to the Hazard Mitigation Plan for Bartlett. He is working with the NH Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to obtain a grant to help with the costs of this project. He dropped off informational papers on Beck Disaster Recovery, Inc. (BDR). BDR is one of the nation's premier emergency management and disaster readiness and recovery firms, dedicated to helping local, state and federal government agencies to recover from natural and man-made disasters. Chairman Chandler inquired if the State is ok with using BDR. King stated that they don't care who you use. King stated that they will sit down with the police department, fire department and administrative assistant and they will assist when the town holds the required public meetings. King wanted to know if the town would pay the money up front and then get reimbursed by the State as the State isn't very prompt at paying. Chairman Chandler stated that the State should pay the contractor directly and he wouldn't vote for the town to pay the contractor and wait for the state to reimburse the town. King stated that if he has any problems he will be back in touch with the Selectmen.

John Cingranelli (2RT016-208-M103) telephoned the Selectmen concerning water regulations as his water had been shut off. Chairman Chandler explained that it is not town water and this would be a civil issue.

The Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 12:10 PM.
