

Town of Bartlett Board of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes: February 29, 2008
Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Doug Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

Selectman Tanguay made a motion at 08:45 AM to enter nonpublic session to discuss a request for aid according to RSA 91-A: 3 (c). Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Chairman Chandler made a motion at 09:05 AM to end the nonpublic session. Selectman Tanguay seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The Selectmen discussed the following:

- 1.) Shoveling the roofs at the Glen Fire Station and the Bartlett Highway garage. Rick Murnik will shovel the Glen Fire Station and Glen Builders will shovel the highway garage.
- 2.) The handling of the request from Blueberry Village to have someone do inspections of the property to bring them to code with fire alarms, etc. was discussed at the request of Fire Chief Roberts. The Selectmen agreed that Ann Chase, property manager, should be contacted and she should get in touch with Engineer Shawn Bergeron directly and make the necessary arrangements for these inspections.
- 3.) Billing procedures were discussed in reference to Engineer Burr Phillips doing road construction observations. It was decided that to keep things moving forward in each project that the deposit would be held until we receive a finalized bill from Phillips.
- 4.) Proposed employee wages were discussed.

Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.
