Meeting Minutes: April 30, 2010

Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Douglas Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

Chairman Chandler opened the (TAN) tax anticipation note bid and the Selectmen have some questions in reference to the bid and decided to hold off on making any decision at this time.

Road Agent, Travis Chick, discussed the following with the Selectmen, 1.) Chick would like to get internet service at the garage so that he can go on line to look up parts, etc. Chairman Chandler inquired as to how often would he use it. Chick replied that more and more vendors are doing business by internet now. Selectman Tanguay commented that Chick could also get the winter weather forecasts. It was agreed that Selectman Tanguay would check into getting this service. 2.) Chick inquired about two culverts, one on Cobb Farm Road and the other at the entrance to Stillings' Grant as he doesn't believe they get much use so do we want to upgrade them when we redo the road. Chairman Chandler replied that historically it used to wash out and that is why the culverts were put in but he doesn't believe Chick needs to worry about it now. 3.) Chick would like to purchase an auto self-leveling laser which is a measuring device that could be used by one person. Chairman Chandler stated that we didn't budget for it. Selectman Garland inquired as to the cost of the laser. Chick replied that it would be \$750.00. Selectman Garland inquired if we could rent one from Lucy Hardware. Chick didn't know so Selectman Garland telephoned Lucy Hardware and the cost to rent one is \$50.00 a day or \$37.50 for a half day. Chick stated that he would be constantly using one for grading, putting in culverts, etc. while they work on the road project. Selectman Garland felt that it would be more economical to buy one of our own. The Selectmen gave Chick permission to order the laser. 4.) Chick informed the Selectmen that he had problems with diesel coming out of the engine area of the one ton truck and had to have it transported to the repair garage.

Chairman Chandler made a motion at 09:35 Am to enter nonpublic session to discuss a request for aid under NH RSA 91-A: 3 II (c). Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Selectman Tanguay made a motion at 09:50 AM to end the nonpublic session and to seal the

minutes. Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Brad Loomis from Starting Point telephoned the Selectmen as he would like to meet up with the Welfare Directors to provide brochures and information as to what Starting Point has to offer people. It was agreed that Lumis would meet with the Selectmen at 09:00 AM on May 7th.

The Selectmen had received a complaint in reference to an individual selling carved wooden bears out of the back of his pickup truck on weekends at the Irving Station parking lot. A letter will be written as a vendor permit was never filed with the Selectmen.

The Selectmen reviewed and discussed the abatement form requests. Decisions were made on a case by case basis.

The Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.
