Meeting Minutes: May 14, 2010

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

Stephen Gallas, a representative of Lower Bartlett Water Precinct, met with the Selectmen to explain the proactive view that they are doing to find out what may contaminate the Lower Bartlett Water Precinct well. They are contacting commercial businesses to update their records in case of a spill as to who they should contact. He is planning on having informal meetings with the businesses and to teach them how to care for chemicals, etc. so as to safeguard the water. Chairman Chandler inquired if this was for the precinct only. Gallas replied yes just in the precinct as their records have old information on them and they want to update the information. Gallas stated that the goal is to update records and to educate the business on how to keep the water clean as they would like to be proactive to avoid such things like the oil spill that is going on now in the Gulf of Mexico. Selectman Garland inquired what businesses would he be speaking to. Gallas replied that it would be businesses from the East Branch River to the North Conway Water Precinct as well as the New England Inn on Route 16A. Gallas stated that there would be nothing negative coming from this survey as they just want to keep the water clean not only for this generation but for generations to come.

The Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 10:40 AM.
