

Town of Bartlett Office of Selectmen

Meeting Minutes: May 21, 2010

Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Douglas Garland, Jon Tanguay

Reporters: None

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

Road Agent, Travis Chick, informed the Selectmen that he had received a price quote of \$62,333.60 from Pike Industries for the work to be done on Cobb Farm Road. Selectman Tanguay inquired if Pike chews up the pavement, the town puts gravel down and then Pike resurfaces the road. Chick replied yes and right now the pavement is anywhere from 3 ½ inches to 7" deep. Chick mentioned that it would be mid June before this project is started. Selectman Garland inquired if he is going to shim by Katherine Ryan's (5COBRD-23-RWO). Chick will have to see as the Stanton Farm section to Bill Duggan's (5COBRD-34-RWO) and by Jim Howards (5COBRD-45-RWO) is the worst section of road. Selectman Tanguay inquired if Chick had heard anything from Time Warner about getting internet connection to the garage. Chick replied "No". Selectman Tanguay will check into this further.

Andrew Coyle (1INTPK-HIL-20) requested that the drainage ditch by his residence, 10 Hillside Avenue, be cleaned out as it hasn't been done for two years. Coyle stated that the water coming down the road is washing out his yard as it is all ending up at his property. The culvert that is on Keith Road behind Henry Allen's (1RT16A-52-R00) drains to the Ala-Bye Ski Club (1INTPK-HIL-10) and onto his property. He understands that they are trying to drain the water to the culvert on Route 16A but right now it is ending up at his property. Selectman Garland inquired if Coyle owns the property so that perhaps a bigger trench could be put in. Coyle replied, "Yes". Chairman Chandler will have the road agent check this drainage issue out.

Tim Khrapunov of Glen Chill Out (2RT016-192-R00) brought in a copy of an inspection report from Bergeron Technical Services which the Selectmen reviewed and after doing so a permit to occupy was issued. He is planning on opening next Friday the 28<sup>th</sup> of May.

Selectman Tanguay made a motion at 10:00 AM to enter nonpublic session to discuss a request for aid under NH RSA 91-A: 3 II (c). Chairman

Chandler seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Selectman Garland made a motion at 10:15 AM to end the nonpublic session and to seal the minutes. Selectman Tanguay seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.
