Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

A concerned citizen from Jackson telephoned the Selectmen and informed them that the Town of Jackson is discussing dissolving the joint transfer station. They want to put a fence down the middle of the transfer station with Jackson being on one side and Bartlett on the other. He also stated that they had fired their road agent as well. The Selectmen thanked the caller for the information.

Selectman Tanguay had attended the library committee meeting and the main topic of discussion was the purchasing of land for a new library. Selectman Tanguay reminded them that they might want to figure out the size of the septic system that would be needed so that they could determine the size of the lot needed.

Chief Connifey updated the Selectmen that Justin Ross would be attending NH Police Standards and Training in Concord starting August 25<sup>th</sup> to obtain his part time officer certification. The Selectmen agreed that he could use a cruiser to go to the trainings which will be on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday and that he would not be paid for drive time.

The Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters, discussed legal issues and signed checks throughout the meeting.
