Meeting Minutes: July 1, 2010

Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Douglas Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

Annette Libby, Bartlett Recreation Director, met with the Selectmen to update them on the summer recreation program. The program starts on July 5th and they will be going swimming that day. She had a lot of applicants and each week she has 58 in the program. Libby attended a water safety course held in Madison and the liability factor was an eye opener. Selectman Tanguay inquired if any of our staff were life guard trained. Libby replied, no, and that is why they always go to a place that does have a life guard on duty. They will also be doing things a little different this year. Libby inquired about the tent on the trailer for the 3rd of July as she has no one to put it up this year. The Selectmen were fine with no tent on the trailer. Libby stated that she is also having an additional porta-potty this year so that there would be one located at the Black Fly field where the parade forms and one at the Hodgkin's Park where the parade finishes. Selectman Garland stated that Bartlett Service Center has made changes to their dooryard and the line up of parade participants will need to be changed as there won't be enough room to park the fire trucks there this year. He also mentioned that the access into the ball field through the gate was an issue last year. The Mount Washington Band can't get in the gate. Chairman Chandler suggested that we reserve a space on the side of the road in front of the ball field for the band. Selectman Garland suggested that parade participants go behind the backstop to enter and only exit by way of the gate. Libby stated that Tammy Bronekjo, Assistant Recreation Director, will be doing the registrations and if Selectman Garland could do the parking that would be great. Chairman Chandler suggested that the Fire Departments line up on Pine Street and join into the parade at that point. Everyone agreed that would be the best idea and a telephone call was placed to Fire Chief Pat Roberts to let him know this. Libby will check with Bartlett Service Center to see if the band only can park in his lot. Libby also informed the Selectmen that this fall she would like to finish cleaning up Black Fly ball field as there is some brush, etc. that still needs to be removed. Selectman Tanguay stated that he would go today and do some weed whacking along the fence so that it would look better when the parade participants are there.
