

Town of Bartlett Office of Selectmen

Date: August 12, 2011

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

Police Chief Timothy Connifey requested to go into nonpublic session with the Board of Selectmen for an ongoing case investigation.

Chairman Chandler made a motion at 09:10 AM to enter into nonpublic session under NH RSA: 91-A: 3 II (c). Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Selectman Patch made a motion at 09:25 AM to end the nonpublic session and to seal the minutes. Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Chandler made a motion at 09:35 AM to enter nonpublic session to discuss a request for aid under NH RSA 91-A: 3 II (c). Selectman Patch seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Selectman Garland made a motion at 10:00 AM to end the nonpublic session and to seal the minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

The Selectmen reviewed applications and information forwarded to them by the Bartlett Recreation Director. These documents were for the hiring of someone to run the afternoon Kids Kaleidoscope program at the Josiah Bartlett School. Selectman Patch had participated in the interview process of the applicants. The Selectmen reviewed the information presented to them and agreed to hire Cheri Iannuzzi for the position. The Selectmen agreed that she would have a probation period of four weeks and they also would like her to attend a Selectmen's meeting so that they could meet her.

The Selectmen discussed the bid results for the financing of a note for the property revaluation that was submitted by Northway Bank. (They were the only bidders) It was decided that they would accept the three year loan at the interest rate of 1.96% which would mean the interest would be around \$8,330.00. The interest for a four year loan was 2.38% making that interest to be around \$13,685. The five year loan interest rate was 2.79% making that interest payment about \$20,228.00.
