

Town of Bartlett Office of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes: September 12, 2008
Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Douglas Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

Sheila Duane, Project Manager, Attitash Mountain Service Co., Inc., met with the Selectmen to discuss maintaining the cap at the old Bartlett landfill. Duane stated that she was told that there are trees that are growing there and they were wondering if the town was going to mow the cap. Chairman Chandler stated that we do mow it every year. Duane stated that the trees look like they have been there awhile and they would like to keep the integrity of the closure cap so that nothing can penetrate it. Selectman Garland replied that we must be missing that area as he doesn't know how far down they mow on the sides but they do at least mow the top. Duane had plans that showed the cap and those plans were reviewed by the Selectmen. Selectman Garland believes that the plan shows the cap larger than what we have been mowing. Selectman Garland stated the way the cap is defined he believes it is safe to say that it goes from the bottom of the slope to the raised portion. Duane stated that they would like to see it maintained so that nothing gets out from underneath. Selectman Garland will take a look at the area.

Bob Carper (2GLEN-82-0) met with the Selectmen about a special events permit for the Chamber of Commerce After Hours event for approximately 80 people that he is hosting at his residence at 456 Glen Ledge Road on September 16th. The Selectmen had reviewed his application and it was approved with the condition that any parking on the town road would be limited to one side and the other side should be marked no parking. Carper inquired if all private parties have to have a special event permit as he has been to other parties on Glen Ledge that he doesn't believe they got a permit. Chairman Chandler stated that the number of people is a factor and that others on Glen Ledge have gotten permits. Selectman Garland explained that it is not a private party as it is done by an organization and any member of the Chamber of Commerce could attend. Chairman Chandler mentioned that this event has also been advertised in the newspaper.

Chairman Chandler had a prior commitment and had to leave the meeting at 09:50 AM.
