Meeting Minutes: October 17, 2008

Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler, Douglas Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

Annette Libby, Bartlett Recreation Director, met with the Selectmen to discuss the following:

- 1.) Mark Linehan of Village Green has donated the supplies and his time to put weed killer and fertilizer on the Black Fly ball field which will be done within the next few days.
- 2.) Libby had two applicants for the position of running the kids kaleidoscope. It was agreed that she would hire Amara Kennett at \$10.00 per hour. A review would be done in 60 days. Libby, because of the economy right now, is reducing the cost from \$8.00 per child to \$5.00 for the first child in the family and \$3.00 for each sibling. There will be no snacks this year.
- 3.) Libby requested that the Selectmen think about and give her a list of the dignitaries to invite to the Christmas tree lighting ceremony on December 6, 2008.
- 4.) Fencing at the Black Fly ball field was discussed and it was decided for financial reasons that at the present time they will use boulders with trees planted between them which will also help to reestablish the green space.

Selectman Garland made a motion at 09:50 AM to enter nonpublic session for a request for aid according to RSA 91-A: 3 (c). Selectman Tanguay seconded the motion. Chairman Chandler recused himself. Motion carried. Selectman Tanguay made a motion at 10:10 AM to end the nonpublic session and to seal the minutes. Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The Selectmen addressed a legal issue with the town attorney, Douglas Mansfield.
