

Town of Bartlett Office of Selectmen - Meeting Minutes: October 30, 2009  
Attendance: Chairman Gene Chandler

Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

Chairman Chandler went into nonpublic session at 08:55 AM according to NH RSA 01-A: 3 II (c) to discuss a request for aid. Chairman Chandler obtained the information and the other Selectmen were contacted by telephone to discuss this request. Chairman Chandler ended the nonpublic session at 09:10 AM.

Chairman Chandler opened the sealed bids for the loader. Two bids were received, reviewed and we are now waiting for additional information from the bidders.

Richard Goff of Glen Ellis Campground (3RT302-37-L01) met to discuss the status of his building permits. One permit for an apartment over the laundramat and the other for an additional room added to the laundry mat for folding clothes. Chairman Chandler gave Goff the permits and explained that he will have to have a life safety code inspection done. Goff replied that he can't afford that as when his barn/recreation room was done it costs him a lot of money. Goff inquired if Chairman Chandler had given any thought to the fact that these inspections could be a conflict of interest as it behooves the inspector to fail him so they can get more money. Chairman Chandler explained that he didn't care who he had do the inspection but before the permit to occupy was issued the town would need a letter from a qualified inspector.

A Letter of Map Revision to the Floodplain was received for the property owned by Jon and Karen Hebert at 13 East Branch Rd. Documentation was presented by their surveyor showing their property is not within the floodplain. Selectmen approved the request.

A letter of resignation was received from Christine Legendre as the Assistant Recreation Director. Selectmen will send a letter accepting her resignation. Chairman Chandler reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks. (Selectman Tanguay had been in earlier during the week and had also reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks.)

Meeting adjourned at 10:40 AM.
