

Town of Bartlett Board of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes: November 16, 2007
Attendance: Gene Chandler, Douglas Garland, Jon Tanguay

Meeting opened at 08:30 AM.

Annette Libby, Bartlett Recreation Director, introduced Tammy Bronejko as the new coordinator for the Kids Kaleidoscope program at the Josiah Bartlett School. Libby is planning on having a meet and greet day to introduce Bronejko to the students and their parents. Libby has been working on making a welcome packet, updating the employee handbook and making up a new employment application form. Copies of the handbook and the employment application were given to the Selectmen for them to review and to make changes.

Bartlett Fire Chief L. Pat Roberts updated the Selectmen on the following:

- 1.) He has been in contact with Don Ryder (Bear Mountain Enterprise) and Ryder is still interested in doing the routine maintenance on the forestry and ladder truck but doesn't feel he has the time right now to do the other vehicles as he is trying to get his new home built. Roberts contacted Paul at Conway Truck and he is willing to do the work, but the trucks need to be taken to his shop in Conway. Selectman Tanguay inquired if Paul could come to the highway garage to do the work. Roberts didn't know. Chairman Chandler stated that it wouldn't make much difference as we would have to pay his travel time so we might as well take the trucks to Conway. Chairman Chandler would like to see a maintenance schedule set up for next year. Roberts will see if he can set something up with Don Ryder (Bear Mountain Enterprise). Chairman Chandler inquired if Roberts felt the town road crew could do the oil changes, etc. Roberts replied that we need to hire a mechanic. Chairman Chandler stated that there wouldn't be enough work to hire a full time mechanic and he will speak to the road agent, Travis Chick, to see if perhaps the road crew could do some oil changes.
- 2.) Roberts has spoken to Glenn at Lakes Region Fire Apparatus and he will put the ladder truck up on his lift and get the boom section steam cleaned to make sure we are correcting the right problem as it appears there is corrosion starting on the frame. The Selectmen would like to have Glenn give a report of what he finds and then a decision would be made as to where we go from there.

Road Agent, Travis Chick, informed the Selectmen that Allen Eastman of A. Eastman and Son would not be plowing Linderhof for the town this year. The Selectmen discussed who else might be interested in doing this and if perhaps we needed to hire a part time person to drive one of the town trucks. Chick will make some inquiries and get back to the Selectmen.

The Board of Selectmen discussed and agreed to engage Engineer Burr Phillips to work on the Birchview road right of way issue to determine the width of the Town's right of way.

Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.
