

Town of Bartlett Board of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes: December 28, 2007

Meeting opened at 08:35 AM.

Donna Webster (1DNDRD-49-R00) requested an explanation on her tax bill as the value jumped dramatically on the lot which is only used as a storage place and the roof is falling in, windows falling in as well as parts of the floor. Selectman Tanguay inquired if this building is only used for storage. Webster stated yes that she and her children have items stored in the building and that the building is only a cellar hole with a roof on it. Chairman Chandler looked at the tax card and inquired if the building was a mobile home. Webster replied that she has no mobile homes. Chairman Chandler explained that for some reason, perhaps because they didn't really have a category for the building it was put under a mobile home and when they went up the value of her building went up. Chairman Chandler explained that the bad news was that she has to pay the taxes as is and file for an abatement by March 1st and that we have until July 1st to respond. Chairman Chandler gave Webster an abatement form and a copy of her tax cards.

Selectman Garland had a prior commitment and left the meeting at 11:15 AM.

Bert George of the Historical Society brought in some photographs for the Selectmen to review to possibly put on the front page of the town report. The Selectmen will review this further.

Selectmen reviewed correspondence, starting discussing 2008 budgets, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.
